Waste Management Policy

SLP AlShabah is committed to minimizing environmental impact by managing waste and water responsibly. The waste management policy outlines SLP AlShabah's commitment to reducing waste, promoting sustainable waste management practices, and ensuring compliance with environmental regulations.

Scope: This policy applies to all business operations, offices, and project sites where SLP AlShabah has operational control.

All team members share the responsibility for implementing waste management practices. This includes waste reduction, segregation, and adherence to disposal guidelines. SLP AlShabah is committed to the following waste management principles:

- Ensure that all waste management practices comply with applicable national, regional, and local waste management related regulations and statutory obligations, going beyond the minimum requirements for various waste types, including hazardous waste, e-waste, plastic waste, battery waste.
- Adhere to the 5R (refuse, reduce, reuse, recycle, and responsible disposal) principles to effectively manage waste.
- Set targets for waste reduction, recycling, and reuse, etc. and regularly monitor progress towards these targets.
- Prioritize paperless operations where feasible, encouraging digital communication and document storage, and minimizing single-use plastics.
- Segregate waste into recyclable, non-recyclable, organic and hazardous categories using labeled bins in all workspaces; and partnering with certified recycling agencies for proper waste processing.
- Benchmark waste management parameters against the industry best practices to establish and continuously improve our systems.

SLP AlShabah

- Measure and monitor the total quantities of waste generated, reduced, recycled, reused, or disposed across different waste categories.
- Train employees on the responsible handling and disposal of all categories of waste, including plastics, e-waste, biomedical waste, and batteries.
- Explore innovative strategies and solutions to minimize or limit the quantity and/or toxicity of the waste generated across the business operations.
- Raise awareness amongst internal and external stakeholders on the importance of sustainable waste management practices.

The policy shall be reviewed periodically for its appropriateness and updated as necessary.
